Illinois Prairie Path History Night – North Central College

On Tuesday, May 5 at 7 p.m., Kim Butler, Archivist, North Central College will provide a 45-minute presentation of the *History of the Illinois Prairie Path* at North Central College, Kotten Chapel, 329 East School Street, Naperville. Her presentation will include a restored historic film (1964) that was shown over 400 times to promote regional and statewide support for a public path. In addition, attendees will have an opportunity to view some of the Path's 50 years of archives that will be on display across the street at Oesterle Library.
